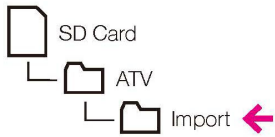



6 Instrument Import

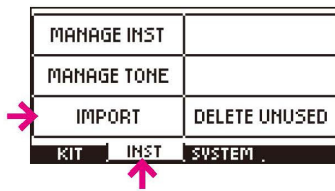
■ Preparation

- 1 Place the downloaded instrument file (xxxx.ad5inst) in the Import folder of the SD card.



■ Import

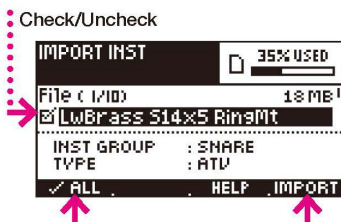
- 1 In the home screen, press .
- 2 Select the [INST] tab, and press [IMPORT].



The IMPORT INST screen appears.

- 3 Use the value knob to select the instrument file that you want to import.

- If you want to import multiple instruments, add a check mark to each file that you want to import.
- If you press the [ALL] button, all files are selected. If you press the button again, all selections are cleared.



- 4 Press [IMPORT].

The import is executed.
A progress bar is shown during the import.

If an instrument of the same name already exists, a message appears.

[RENAME]: Rename and import.
[SKIP]: Skip importing this instrument.

When the import is completed, the screen indicates "Completed."

- 5 Assign the imported instrument to a pad.

For the procedure, refer to "4 Pad edit" (p. 15).

NOTE

If there is no "Import" folder, insert the SD card into the aD5 once, and the folders will be created.

NOTE

The downloaded instrument file can be imported only into an aD5 of the matching product ID. If the product ID does not match, the following message appears.
"Cannot import this data. This aD5 doesn't have permission to import "xxxx."
